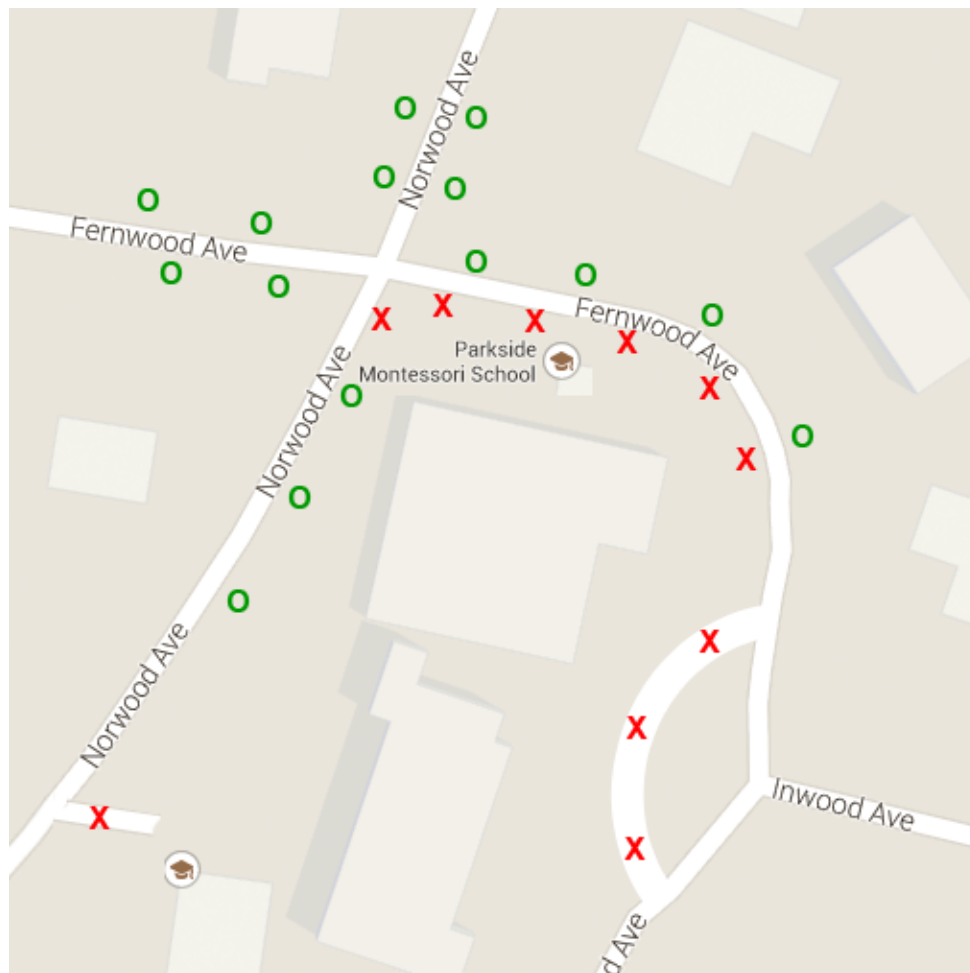


PARKSIDE PARKING GUIDELINES

As we begin another school year, it is important to address the parking situation around Parkside and the Presbyterian Church. We want to ensure the safety of our families. We also want to preserve the quiet atmosphere of this beautiful neighborhood and maintain our good relationships with our neighbors. To that end, we offer these guidelines:

Each morning, the staff sets up orange cones near the entrance on the south side of Fernwood Avenue. Do not park where the cones have been placed nor in either of the church driveways - **X**.

Parking is available on Norwood Avenue, north and south of Fernwood, on both sides of Fernwood west of Norwood and on the north side of Fernwood east of Norwood - **O**.



There are “NO PARKING HERE TO CORNER” signs on both Norwood and Fernwood near our entrance. State and local statutes require that there be at least 25 FEET between a crosswalk and the front of a parked vehicle, and also that there be at least 50 FEET between a STOP sign and the front of a parked vehicle. The police do periodically check and ticket cars that are parked too close to the corners.

Please! Never leave a child unattended in your car when you are dropping off or picking up someone from Parkside. Even though it may be for just a few minutes, it is illegal and extremely unsafe!
